The purpose of our Doggie Daycare program is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for your dogs. To help ensure the safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require all clients to comply with the following requirements:

AGE: All dogs must be 12 weeks or older to attend daycare. All dogs over 6 months of age must be spayed or neutered.

<u>VACCINATIONS</u>: All dogs must have current vaccinations. This includes DA(2)PP, Rabies, and Bordetella. Owners must submit current vaccination records, and whenever vaccinations have been updated.

FEES: Fees are as follows: \$22.00/day for the first dog in the family and \$18.00/day for the second or third dogs in the family. We also do half days at \$13.00. This fee includes a charge of a \$1.00 a day for our Pet Care Promise. We have daycare packages available in a 10 day pass or 20 day pass at a discounted rate. Please note that packages are non-transferable and non-refundable.

LATE PICKUP: Any dog left 30 minutes after closing will be placed in lodging and cared for overnight at applicable rates.

DAYS and HOURS: Monday through Friday 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Saturday 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

HEALTH: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify that their dogs are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any condition which could jeopardize other guests. There are unavoidable viruses and conditions that we may experience by having a community of dogs together but we will make every effort to keep them to a minimum. If your dog is coughing, has diarrhea, or is displaying any signs of being ill, please notify us prior to bringing your dog to daycare. We also require that all dogs be on a flea, tick and heartworm prevention, provided by your veterinarian, all year long.

BEHAVIOR: Owners will certify that their dogs have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog. Please remember, your dog will be spending time with other dogs and their safety and health are our main concern. If a dog is presenting behaviors that are disruptive to the rest of the group, we may have to take steps to change their behavior. The process could be as simple as separating him/her from another dog or the group, or perhaps taking a break from daycare while training classes are attended. In rare cases, we may ask that your dog not return to our daycare program. This does not mean that your dog isn't able to socialize with other dogs, it may simply mean that this environment isn't good for your dog. We ask that your dog wear a regular, properly fitted collar of nylon or leather and come to daycare every day on a leash.

- 2. I understand and agree that any problems which develop with my pet will be treated as deemed best by the staff of Willow Wood Animal Hospital and Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center at their sole discretion, and that I assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses involved.
- 3. I further understand and agree that in admitting my dog(s) to the facility, the Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center staff has relied on my representation that my dog(s) is/are in good health and have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior toward any person or any other dog.

Pet Care Policy

Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center has a long standing reputation for providing the very best care of our clients' pet companions. Based on this reputation and the trust our clients have in our community, we are happy to offer an additional service that underscores our continuing commitment to provide the highest quality of pet care.

Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center has a Pet Care Policy that will reimburse our clients up to \$500 in eligible veterinary expenses for illnesses or injuries that occur due to their visit. The details of this benefit for our clients' pet are presented below.

Which Pets are covered?

All pets lodging at Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center or participating in the Doggie Daycare program will be covered by the Pet Care Policy.

Eligible Expenses

Eligible expenses include diagnostic and/or treatment expenses provided by a licensed veterinarian that are directly related to an illness or injury that arises as a result of the pet's visit to Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center. This includes illness or injuries that arise during the pet's visit, or illness or injuries that become evident up to five days after the pet leaves. Expenses that are not eligible for reimbursement include: pre-existing conditions; illnesses or injuries sustained by the pet before arriving at Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center; age-related illnesses or injuries; injuries inflicted by pets in the same family; illnesses to pets whose vaccinations are not current; airborne illnesses; and any natural disasters including hurricanes, tornados, and floods.

Maximum reimbursement:

The maximum reimbursement is \$500 per year.

Fee

The Pet Care Policy is provided for a nominal charge of only \$1 per pet per day, which will be included automatically on the owner's invoice when payment is made for lodging or doggie daycare.

How to seek reimbursement

Pet owners must follow these steps in order to request reimbursement for eligible expenses:

- The illness or injury must be reported to the General Manager within five days of the pet's departure from Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center to qualify for reimbursement, and the pet must have been evaluated by a licensed veterinarian within these five days.
- The pet owner is responsible for paying all veterinary expenses directly to the licensed veterinarian or animal clinic. Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center will not make payment to the veterinarian. To

- be eligible for reimbursement, the pet owner is also required to make full payment to Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center for any lodging or doggie daycare expenses incurred during their pet's visit.
- 3. The pet owner must submit a copy of the veterinarian's diagnosis and treatment charges within two weeks of the pet's departure from Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center. The request for reimbursement should be submitted to the General Manager via e-mail, fax, or hand-delivery to ensure the information is received promptly.
- 4. Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center may require a conference call with the treating veterinarian to learn more about the illness or injury or confirm that the illness or injury was not due to any pre-existing conditions. In these cases, pet owners must give their veterinarian authorization to speak to a Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center manager regarding their pet's condition. Otherwise, the warranty will be void.
- 5. Within 10 days of receiving the request for reimbursement and a copy of veterinary expenses and diagnosis, Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center will mail a check payable to the pet owner to reimburse eligible expenses up to a maximum or \$500 per year. If there is any question about the applicability or necessity of diagnostic test or treatment, Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center will seek the counsel of one or more independent veterinarians prior to determining final reimbursement eligibility, which shall be determined in Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Centers' sole discretion. Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center maintains the right to disqualify expenses that are not in the opinion of our consulting veterinarians, directly related to the diagnosis and/or treatment of the pet's illness or injury.

Cancellation

Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center may terminate this Pet Care Policy at any time. If cancelled, Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center shall reimburse the owner for eligible veterinarian expenses incurred during the period of time in which the Pet Care Policy fee was charged to the owner.

Owner's Acknowledgment

I understand the terms and condition of the Pet Care Policy. I also understand that this program will continue indefinitely until Willow Wood Pet Resort and Training Center notifies its customers of any changes to the terms and conditions.

Severability

If any part of this Agreement shall be deemed unenforceable or illegal or in conflict with the General Statues of the State under which this Agreement shall be governed, then the parties agree that the portion of this Agreement deemed illegal or in conflict with the Statues shall be void, but the remainder of the Agreement shall be valid and enforceable.
